

- 6. The ministry organized a day's workshop for 12 young people seeking for educational support to university; to help them understand the vision of FHCM, life in tertiary and how they would cope, concentrate and achieve their dreams of gaining degrees by knowing God's purpose for their lives.
- 7. Organized a 2-day Praises Night to thank God for how far He has brought the ministry at Anto.
- 8. Organized our annual Christmas party at Anto where children from the community were invited and treated to food, sweets and gifts.

- 1. Approved educational support for 10 non-resident young people who are in various universities across the country reading various degrees.
- 2. One of our young people have gained admission to tertiary to read B. Ed. Primary Education at Holy Child Col-

lege of Education

- 3. 9 young people completed their various degrees and are doing their national service in various departments, agencies and organisations across the country.
- 4. Commissioned the library and computer lab complex project with support from Bosch Rexroth Gh. Ltd with pictures below.

- 1. To sustain and deepen existing cordial relationship with friends and supporters of the ministry both locally and internationally as we strive to create new relationships for Father's Home to achieve our vision.

- 3. To continue re-integrating children and youth whose cases have been worked on and are ready to be re-unified with their families
- 4. Maintenance and expansion of the Agricultural project (vegetables, Catfish & Piggery) at Anto.
- 5. To maintain the social media platforms being run by the ministry i.e Facebook, WhatsApp, Instagram and Website to reach out to more people to join hands in the support of the ministry.

1. To continue preparing young people in university for independent adult life.

RECOMMENDATION

- Would entreat the DSW and DOVSSU to expedite work on finding and tracing families of children who are brought to the home for temporary care and protection as they stay longer making it difficult for the home to decide on their education and other essential needs which is disrupted when they are moved abruptly and thus affect their growth and psychological development.
- 2. Encourage the DSW to follow up on children who are brought to the home as they virtually abandoned them because they have found a place for the children especially children with special needs who are now "permanent residents" of the home.
- 3. Encourage the supervising authorities to do well to visit and monitor our activities as it helps in keeping up with government new policies and learn from their expertise.
- 4. Appeal to government agencies to give optimum support to the ministry when it comes to renewal of certificates and other documents that helps in the effective running of the children.
